



Old Mission Santa Barbara Photography & Videography Policies

Personal Photography Policy

Photography is encouraged at Old Mission Santa Barbara. You do not need a permit if photographs are taken by family or friends without compensation. However, please follow these rules:

1. No flash photography, tripods & monopods, or reflector screens are permitted.
2. The use of images and likenesses of Old Mission Santa Barbara is not permitted for any commercial/political enterprise or advertisement.

Professional Photography Policy

A permit is required for professional photography. Professional photography is when a professional photographer is receiving compensation to take photographs (posed or un-posed), and employs the use of equipment such as tripods, lights, reflector shields, etc.

Please note that reservations are required **10 days** in advance.

Reservations can be made Monday-Friday between 8:00am-5:00pm (last time slot is 3:00pm-5:00pm). Reservations for weekends are by special approval and subject to availability.

Requirements for Photography Permit

1. Approved time and date scheduled with a staff member at Old Mission Santa Barbara.

2. Minimum of two hours with a rate of **\$150 per hour** (or part of). A non-refundable reservation fee of \$50 is required. A credit card is required to be on file in case time must be extended.
3. General Liability requirement of \$1 million naming Old Mission Santa Barbara as co-insured.
4. Completed and finalized Photography agreement.

Professional Videography Policy

A permit is required for professional videography. Professional videography is when a professional filmmaker or crew is receiving compensation to take videos, and employs the use of equipment such as tripods, lights, reflector shields, or use of actors/models.

Please note that reservations are required **10 days** in advance.

Reservations can be made Monday-Friday between 8:00am-5:00pm (last time slot is 3:00pm-5:00pm). Reservations for weekends are by special approval and subject to availability.

Requirements for Videography Permit

1. Approved time and date scheduled with a staff member of Old Mission Santa Barbara.
2. Minimum of two hours with a rate of **\$250 per hour** (or part of). A non-refundable reservation fee of \$100 is required. A credit card is required to be on file in case time must be extended.
3. General Liability requirement of \$1 million naming Old Mission Santa Barbara as co-insured.
4. Completed and finalized Videography agreement.
